

LANCASTER FELLWALKERS October 1 2017

Lancaster Fellwalkers returned to Yorkshire walked to Malham for their first outing of the winter programme.

3 Groups started from Settle. Jim Shepherd led the B group to Upper Settle and Lambert Lane, along the bridleway to Malham Cove and into Malham, covering 8 ½ miles and 1000 feet of ascent. The A group, led by Mark Scarisbrick, passed Vicoria and Jubilee caves, took the bridleway to Langscar Gate then on to Malham Tarn, Malham Cove, and back via Goredale Bridge and Janet's Foss, 11 ½ miles and 950 feet.

The A+ group with Alan Brindley leading, also started via the 2 caves, went on to Capon Hall and the Pennine Way, passed Malham Tarn, New Close Knott, Shorkley Hill and Malham Cove, 15 miles and 2750 feet. Paul Dowling started with the A- group at Coniston Cold, passing through the pretty villages of Bell Busk and Airton and along the Pennine Way to Malham Cove then on to Janet's Foss, 9 ½ miles and 1100 feet.
