

## **LANCASTER FELLWALKERS March 4 2018**

Lancaster Fellwalkers enjoyed Sunday's walks in the Eden Valley, though the lying snow and wintry conditions meant that some had to be adapted.

The A+ walk started at Shap, with John Ashall leading them via Keld, Rosgill, Bampton Grange, Knipe Scar, Whale, Askham and Tirril, to follow the Eden to Eamont Bridge and Penrith, covering 15 miles and 1700 feet of ascent. Alison Barrow led the A group from Thrimby via Bessy Gill, over Heughscar Hill, through Celleron and Sockbridge then along the river to Brougham Castle and Penrith, 15 ½ miles and 1300 feet.

The A- group started at Lowther, led by Frank Whittle through Askham, over Askham Fell to the Cockpit, down Heughscar Hill to Kirkbarrow and Sockbridge and along the Eden to Eamont then Penrith, 10 miles and 1000 feet. Judith Brown led the B group from Hackthorpe via Round Hill to Whale then north through Lowther Park and along Earl Henry's Drive to Eamont Bridge, Mayburgh Henge and Penrith, 9 miles and 700 feet.
