

LANCASTER FELLWALKERS April 1 2018

Lancaster Fellwalkers enjoyed a fine day with excellent views on Sunday in the Mallerstang valley, ending in Kirkby Stephen for refreshments.

The A group, led by John Ashall, started near Garsdale station and walked over Swarth Fell, Wild Boar Fell, The Nab, Hazelgill, Lady Anne's Way, Nateby and into Kirkby Stephen, covering 14 ½ miles and 200 feet of ascent. Mike Codd started with the A+ group near Garsdale and ascended to Lady Anne's Way, Hell Gill Bridge, Gregory Chapel, High Seat, High Pike, Dukerdale Potts, Careless Bank, to Nine Standards and then down, 15 ½ miles and 2800 feet.

The B group were led by Florence Lawson from Aisgill Moor Cottages up to Hell Gill Bridge then along Lady Anne's Way down to Thrang and along the river Eden, past Pendragon Castle, Lammerside Castle, Wharton Hall and the Viaduct Path, 9 miles and 800 feet. Malcolm Thomason took the A- group from Elmsgill over Little Fell, past Moor Pot, Croop House, Wharton Hall, Nateby and the Viaduct Path, 9 ½ miles and 1300 feet.
