

## **LANCASTER FELLWALKERS 10 June 2018**

Lancaster Fellwalkers enjoyed their annual 'extended day' of walks from Loweswater to Buttermere in glorious sunshine.

The B group, led by Kate Brindley, began the 'Three Lakes Walk' at Lanthwaite Green, passed through Loweswater Village, then to Holme Wood and Maggie's Bridge through High Park and then followed the West side of Crummock Water to Buttermere Lake, a total of 10 miles and 1400 feet of ascent.

Peter Brookes, leading the A- group, departed the coach at Buttermere. From Scarth Gap they ascended Haystacks, continued down to Gatesgarth and returned to Buttermere Village via the lake shore; 8.5 miles and 2200 feet of ascent.

John Whitehead led the A group from Lanthwaite Green to Hopegill Head, Coledale Hause and on to Grasmoor, Crag Hill, Wandope and Whiteless Pike returning to Buttermere; 9.5 miles and 3700 feet of ascent.

The A+ group, led by David Ward, also began at Lanthwaite Green and via Maggie's Bridge, ascended Burnbank Fell, Blake Fell, Gavel Fell, Great Borne, Starling Dodd, Little Dodd and Red Pike returning to Buttermere Village, a total of 13 miles and 4100 feet of ascent.
