

## **LANCASTER FELLWALKERS JULY 8 2018**

Lancaster Fellwalkers travelled to Pateley Bridge last Sunday and explored the area around Brimham Rocks, with the weather continuing to supply excellent walking conditions.

John Davies took the A+ walkers up to Yorke's Folly, over Heyshaw Moor to Dacre, Darley and Hartwith, past Brimham Hall and back along the Nidderdale Way, covering 16 miles and 2450 feet of ascent. The A group, led by Lawson Atkinson, went via Bewerly to Yorke's Folly, then on to Henhsaw, Summerbridge, Braisty and Brimham Rocks, also returning along the Nidderdale Way, 12 ½ miles and 2000 feet.

Richard Wickes led the A- group on the Panorama walk through Knottside, Blazefield and White Houses, then on a circuit of Brimham Rocks, taking the riverside walk back through Smelthouses, Knox Hall and Glasshouses, 10 ½ miles and 1400 feet. The B walk was taken by David Ward along the river past Harewell Hall to Summerbridge, Hartwith Bank and Brimham Rocks, returning on the Nidderdale Way past White Houses and Blazefield, 9 miles and 1250 feet.
