

LANCASTER FELLWALKERS September 30 2018

Lancaster Fellwalkers travelled to the Keswick area on Sunday, on a windy day of sunshine and showers, with the first autumn colours showing in the trees.

The A group was first to start, led by Andy Pickering from Mungrisedale Lane end, over Souther Fell, Scales Fell and Blencathra, then down to the Blencathra Centre, over Latrigg and into Keswick, covering 12 ½ miles and 3400 feet of ascent. Helen Nixon also took the A-group from Scales over Scales Fell and Blencathra, then down to the Blencathra centre and back along the Cumbria Way, 9 ½ miles and 2400 feet.

The A+ and B groups both started at Threlkeld. Judith Brown led the B group to the Castlerigg Stone Circle, then via Castlerigg Farm and Rake Foot over Walla Crag, down to Ashness Bridge and back along the lakeside footpath, 9 ½ miles and 1350 feet. The A+ group was led by David Ward along the Cumbria Way to Skiddaw House, over Burnt Horse Shoulder and Lonsdale Pike, on to Little Man and Skiddaw, then down Carl Side, over Dodd and back via Millbeck, 13 ½ miles and 4200 feet.
