

LANCASTER FELLWALKERS November 25 2018

Lancaster Fellwalkers travelled to the Torver area on Sunday, enjoying walks in bright sunshine and with very clear views of the surrounding fells.

First to leave the coach was the A- group at Lowick Bridge, led by Malcolm Thomason to join the Cumbria Way to Tottlebank, past Beacon Tarn, and down along the shore of Coniston Water, then into Torver by the old railway line, covering 10 miles and 1100 feet of ascent. Hilda Preston led the B group from Blawith up to Greenholme Farm, along Beacon Tarn , over Stable Harvey Moss and Lower Torver Moss, past Moor Farm and into Torver, 8 miles and 800 feet.

The A group started in Torver and went to Beacon Tarn, through Spunham Wood and Green Moor, then back via Yew Bank into Torver, 9 ½ miles and 1900 feet. Jane Birbeck took the A+ group from Torver over Broughton Moor and Water Yeat Bridge, Broadslack Crag, Caw, Green Pike, White Pike, White Maiden and into Torver, 11 miles and 2500 feet.
