

LANCASTER FELLWALKERS January 6 2019

Lancaster Fellwalkers enjoyed misty but mild conditions on Sunday for their walks which ended in Ings.

The A+ group were first to start from Staveley, led by Gabby MacPherson through the Green Quarter, over Shipman Knotts, along High Lane into Kentmere then back via Browfoot and Hugill Hall to Ings, covering 13 ½ miles and 1700 feet of ascent. The other three walks all started from Ings. Lawson Atkinson took the A group past Browfoot and along Kentmere Tarn to Kentmere, over Garburn Pass and back via Sallows, Sour Howes, Capple Howe and Grassgarth, 10 ½ miles and 2000 feet.

The A- group were led by Margaret Tyson via Grassgarth and High House to Kentmere, then back along Kentmere Tarn, past Browfoot, Sawmill Cottage and Grassgarth, 9 miles and 1400 feet. Audrey Robinson took the B group south through Whasdike, past School Knott, Droomer and Orrest Head then on to Causeway Farm, Moor Howe, High Borrans, High House and Grassgarth, 7 ½ miles and 950 feet.
